12. Viña Carrasco Merlot, Chile (vg) £17.95
Offers good concentration and depth of fruit, with a soft and plummy texture, and hints of vanilla.

This is a soft, fruity and approachable red. Notes of red cherry and blackcurrant gives this wine a rustic feel.

Dessert Wines

25. Vistamar Late Harvest Moscatel
Chile 125ml glass £5.25 | Half bottle £13.50
Straw yellow in colour with golden highlights. Aromas of white flowers, peach, apricot and quince carry through to a palate of more ripe stone fruits and dried fig flavours.
26. Plaimont, St Mont AOC
France 125ml glass £5.05
The grapes for this luscious wine are derived from the hills south of Armagnac. A blend of local varieties Arrufiac, Petit and Grand Corbu, Petit Manseng are all picked when over-ripe. They are then barrel-fermented and matured on the lees to lend structure and preserve fruitiness. A lovely match to deserts, puddings and to savour at the end of a meal.

White Wines

5. Pinot Grigio Terre al Lago DOC

Italy £21.95

Produced in the sun drenched hills that surround the Lago de Garda. The lake provides a cooling influence on the vines and the Pinot Grigio thrives producing a wine that oozes steeliness, fruit character and length. This is Pinot Grigio at its best.

6. Chapel Down Bacchus (vg)

Kent, England £24.95

The warm summer of 2013 shines through giving intense aromas of grapefruit, gooseberries and freshly cut grass. Fresh with green apple and nettles flavours leaving a clean, crisp finish.

7. Valle Berta Gavi (vg)

Italy £25.95

Subtle traces of honeysuckle with characteristic aromas of lime zest and minerality. It offers a clean and refreshing finish.

8. Bread and Butter Chardonnay

California, USA £21.99

Complex and layered, with distinctive notes of vanilla bean, almond husk and tropical fruit - it's reminiscent of a decadent crême brûlée!

9. Sancerre Blanc Berthier (vg)

France £37.95

Aromas of grapefruit and gooseberry leap from the glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint.

10. Chablis Cape St Martin

Burgundy, France £39.95

This wine is fresh and harmonious with a nicely focused green fruit character and an elegant mineral texture.

Red Wines

17. Baron de Baussac Carigan

France £24.00

This wine is crammed with concentrated and voluptuous black cherry fruit with subtle vanilla providing a polished finish.

18. St Desir Pinot Noir

France £24.95

Showing violets and sweet red berries on the nose the palate is light, velvety and intricate, with integrated toasted notes.

19. 2010 Château Laubès

Bordeaux, France £29.95

This is a wine that is almost mature. With generous black fruits and tannins that are integrated into the texture, the wine is ripe and fruity. The acidity is still there, giving a crisp after taste.

20. Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso La Casetta

Italy £29.95

A beautiful deep ruby hue and lots of cherry, plum and berry fruits complemented by vanilla hints. Fine and rounded, a velvety smooth palate bursting with intense and complex flavours.

21. Esprit de Lussac, Lussac St-Emilion (vg)

Bordeaux, France £31.95

Lovely ruby red with violet reflections and fruit aromas of ripe red fruits on the nose. The palate is fresh and savoury and well balanced with good structure and an excellent finish.

22. Emilio Moro, Ribera del Duero

Spain £32.95

Intense on the palate with layers of concentrated blackberry, toasted herbs, smoke and vanilla. Full bodied with a long length, the remarkably integrated, ripe tannins give a firm structure.

23. Amarone delle Valpolicella Classico, Luciano Arduini

Italy £69.75

This delicious Amarone is full bodied, rich and delicious. With a ruby red color and an intense perfume, this wine has a soft and velvety texture and a scent of dried grapes.
